

Janet's Agricultural Tour

Sweden and Denmark Sept 23 – Oct 2, 2016

The best of South Sweden and Denmark

Sweden is a long country, the south is close to the continental climate and the very north offers a wild mountainous landscape. The best variety of agriculture is offered in the part from our capital Stockholm and south. On a tour in Sweden you will see the typical landscape; forest, open land and water.

Some Highlights in Sweden

- **Sightseeing in Stockholm** with guided visit to The Vasa Museum and City Hall
Stockholm is generally referred to as Beauty on Water, or Venice of the North, the city is built upon 14 islands. It is surrounded by Lake Mälaren, and by the Baltic Sea. The mixture of old and new, greenery and water, picturesque narrow streets and engaging modern broad ones provides an attractiveness you rarely meet elsewhere.
- **Boat Tour** in Stockholm “Under the Bridges”.
- Dinner at the **Open Air Museum Skansen** with more than 150 *historical buildings moved here from nearly every part of Sweden. Most of them date from the 18th and 19th centuries.*
- **Farm visits** – berry production in tunnels and green-houses, the largest ecologic dairy farm in the Nordic countries with 1250 milking cows and a farm with pigs, grain and forest with a private lunch on the farm
- Guided visit at 17th century **Läckö Castle** and dinner at nearby prizewinning restaurant

Some Highlights in Denmark

The Danish landscape is rather unique, as it consists of app 700 islands and a big peninsula, all created through time by sediments from Scandinavian mountains and several glacial periods over millions of years. In ancient times, 1.500- 1.000 years ago, the central part of Scandinavia was a successful center for trade between east and west, with, in particular, migration to England, Ireland, Iceland, Normandy and Kief/Novgorod Russia all made possible thanks to the development of the “long boat”.

- **Farm visit** with app. 500 jersey's. vegetable production, flowers in green houses, pig breeding
- Visit to either the **National Museum of Agriculture** or the **old manor house of noble family**.
- Dinner with local farmers and representatives for Danish agriculture
- Visit to **Roskilde Viking Ship Museum**.
- **Guided city tour** of Copenhagen with the palace of the Danish Royal Family, the Little Mermaid sculpture, we will see Medieval, Renaissance and classical parts of town as well as the modern city.
